- Assist in drafting portfolio dashboards and presentations for executive level meetings
- Advise senior and executive staff on the health of the portfolios.
- Work with the NYS ITS and HCR's Project Management Office on modernization initiatives to assure that data collection and analysis is prioritized in all projects.
- Oversee the drafting of the annual Mitchell-lama report to the NYS legislature.
- Act as OHP's liaison with NYU's Furman Center and other external stakeholders.
